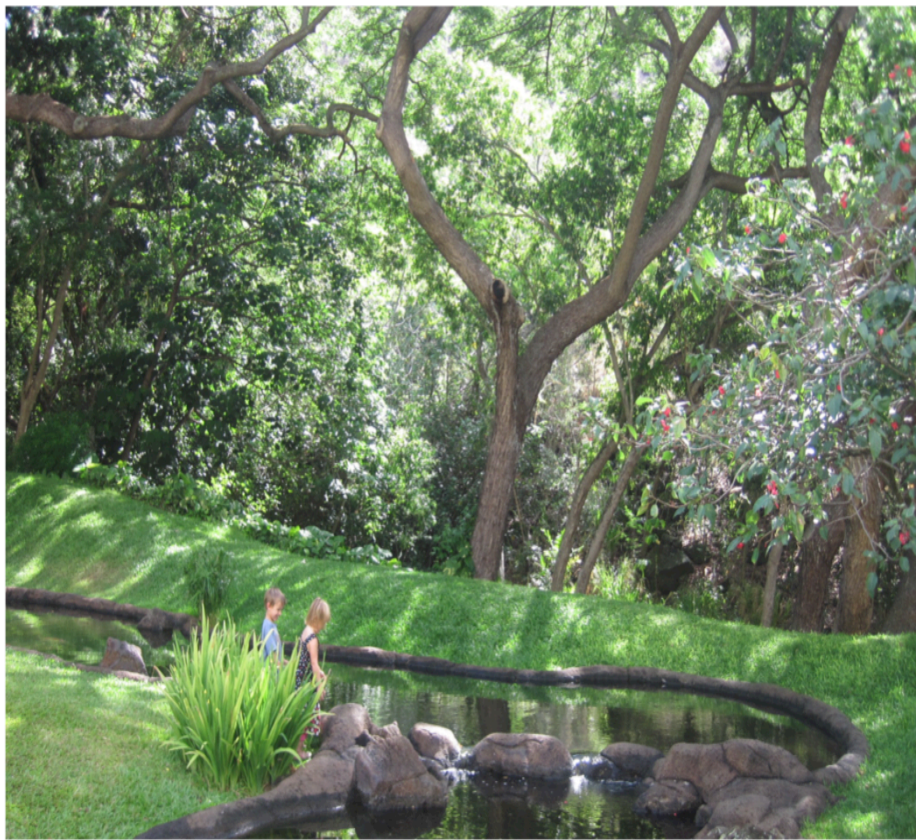


FREE EARLY CHILDHOOD WORKSHOP ON PLACE-BASED EDUCATION
